## Camping in and Near Fergus Falls

**DeLagoon Park.** DeLagoon Park is at the end of the Central Lakes Trail and bicyclists are always welcome! There are toilets but not showers (yet- but they are in the works). Campground fees are \$5.00 a night for tents, \$15.00 a night for campers. Camper hook-ups have water and electric, a maximum stay of 3 nights is enforced. For further information contact the Parks and Recreation Department at 218-739-3205. In Fergus Falls, a dump station is located at the Holiday station on Lincoln Avenue near SunMart grocery store.
